

2020-2021 LIBERTY SAVINGS FEDERAL CREDIT UNION & NEW JERSEY CREDIT UNION FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

THE AWARDS

Liberty Savings Federal Credit Union will be awarding one eligible Senior student in every Hudson County High School with a \$500 scholarship to be used for post high school continuing education.

The New Jersey Credit Union Foundation's scholarship is an award of \$1,000 to be paid jointly to the winning student and the student's chosen accredited educational institution.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a member in good standing of a 2020-2021 Scholarship Program participating credit union and must be enrolled as a high school senior at the time of the application. Scholarship funds must be used for tuition only at an accredited educational institution (community college, 4-year college, university, or technical/vocational school) for the upcoming 2020/2021 school year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please submit one application to apply for both the Liberty Savings FCU and New Jersey Credit Union Foundation scholarships. Eligible members must complete this scholarship application in its entirety and return it to Liberty Savings Federal Credit Union **no later than the March 27, 2020 deadline.**

A student may submit only one application through one credit union. The application must be completed and signed by the student and parent/guardian as well as a management-level official of the student's participating credit union (see page 2). The signed and completed application must be submitted with the following:

- 1.) An official high school transcript that includes a cumulative GPA of completed marking periods as of date of submission. GPA must be NON-WEIGHTED on a 4.0 scale.
- 2.) The completed Teacher Reference portion of the application (see page 4). It must be completed and signed by one of the applicant's teachers. The application (page 2 and 3 of this form), transcript, and Teacher Reference (page 4) must be returned to the participating credit union by the application deadline: March 27, 2020. If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included, the applicant will be disqualified.

SELECTION PROCESS

Judging is based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, community service/involvement, references, and leadership roles. Credit unions will be notified of the scholarship winners by June 1, 2020.
