



2020-2021 LIBERTY SAVINGS FEDERAL CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

THE AWARDS

Liberty Savings Federal Credit Union will be awarding one eligible Senior Student in every Hudson County High School with a \$500 scholarship to be used for post high school continuing education.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a member in good standing of a 2020/2021 Scholarship Program participating credit union and must be enrolled as a high school senior at the time of the application. Scholarship funds must be used for tuition only at an accredited educational institution (community college, 4-year college, university, or technical/vocational school) for the upcoming 2020/2021 school year.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligible members must complete this scholarship application in its entirety and email it to Liberty Savings Federal Credit Union no later than the March 31st, 2021 deadline.

The application must be completed by the student and management-level official of the student's participating credit union (see page 2). The signed and completed application must be submitted with the following:

- 1.) An official high school transcript is preferred which includes a cumulative GPA of completed marking periods as of date of submission. GPA must be NON-WEIGHTED on a 4.0 scale.
- 2.) If you cannot obtain your transcript, your official senior year 2020/2021 Report Card is acceptable.
- 3.) The completed Teacher Reference portion of the application (see page 4). The application (page 2 and 3 of this form), transcript or report card, and Teacher Reference (page 4) must be emailed to Liberty Savings Federal Credit Union by March 31st, 2021. If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included, the applicant will be disqualified.

SELECTION PROCESS

Judging is based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, community service/involvement, references, and leadership roles.
